Eligibility

- The competition is open to all the **Faculty, UG Students, PG/PhD Scholars**.
- Participation may be **individual or group-based**.
- **Only one representative** will be permitted to register, attend and represent the film during the event if selected.
- **There is no registration fee to submit Short film.**

Duration

- The duration of the short film must be **between 8 to 10 minutes**, including opening and closing credits.
- Films exceeding or falling short of the specified duration will not be considered.

Language

- The short film may be in **Hindi, English and Regional Language**.
- Subtitles may be added if required for better understanding.

Theme

- The film should be relevant to the **spirit and objectives of the Akhila Bharatiya Maharshi Charaka Sanskrit Samaroha**.
- Films not aligned with the theme may be disqualified.

Technical Specifications

- Accepted file format: **MP4 / MOV**
- Aspect ratio: **16:9**
- Resolution: **Minimum Full HD (1920 × 1080)**
- Audio quality should be clear and disturbance-free.
- Decent background music can be added.
- The film may be Fictional, Documentary, Animation, or Experimental in format.
