Ayurveda embraces holistic approach to life by catering the apparatus of body, mind and soul. Ayurveda is not merely a system of medicine; it is the way of life. Hence it forms an integral part of Indian culture and tradition. Due to its astuteness, Ayurveda has captured wide international attention and is becoming the modern way to balance mental, emotional and physical health.

Ayurveda primarily aims at preservation of health through daily and seasonal regimes and also provides means to rectify health issues and sufferings of people. Panchakarma therapies are specially designed therapies in Ayurveda for health protection as well as recuperation from disease.

Panchakarma therapies include external application of medicines through Abhyanga (massage), Swedana (fomentation), Lepa (applying packs), Udvartana (powder massage), Murdhni Taila (applying oils in head region through Shirodhara, Shiropichu, Shirobhyanga and Shirobasti) etc and five therapies specially used for detoxification like Vamana (emesis), Virechana (purgation), Nasya (nasal inoculations), Basti (medicated enema) and Raktamokshana (blood-letting). Panchakarma are used as a palliative care, as a biopurification therapy and also as a means for nurturing the body tissues.

Result oriented Panchakarma therapies require proficient staff to handle Purvakarma (preparation phase), Pradhana Karma (main therapy conduction) and Paschat Karma (post-therapy regimen) of Panchakarma. Preshya or Paricharaka (paramedical staff who takes care of the patient and conducts Panchakarma procedure on patient in the presence of Vaidya) is advocated to hold good knowledge of Panchakarma therapies, he/she should be alert, caring and know the importance of maintaining personal hygiene and cleanliness (C. Su. 9/8).

Ayurveda has evolved as evidence based medical system in the recent times and has created global opportunities for people working in the field of Ayurveda. To cater to the needs of entrepreneurship in Ayurveda and specially in Panchakarma, there is a need of highly trained technical staff.

The CVM University, V. V. Nagar, Anand has recognized this demand and are going to start a certificate training course of "Panchakarma Technician" to produce highly skilled Panchakarma Experts.
